ECDC wishes to conclude a framework service contract on providing capacity support to the high-priority Member States (Bulgaria, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania and Romania) in prevention and control of (multidrug resistant — MDR) tuberculosis (TB). The general objectives are: 1) increase the country capacity in (MDR) TB

prevention and control; 2) increase knowledge and skills among TB professionals in the 5 MS; and 3) enable exchange of experiences between professionals working in TB prevention and control among the 5 MS or between these and other MS and institutions. The contractor is expected to supply expertise in the areas of: a) TB surveillance; b) TB laboratory services; c) TB prevention and care; and d) health communication including behaviour change in TB.

In these areas of work, it is expected that the contractor will provide capacity support through: consultancy — short-term experts; training; exchange visits for transferring knowledge and skills.
